

Political parties of Kosovo Serbs in the political system of Kosovo

Political life of Kosovo Serbs is characterized by partocracy and clientelist relations between citizens and political parties in power.



76%

of respondents agree that people join political parties primarily to get a good job.

For only 3 Kosovo Serb political parties can be said that they are still active in political life, namely the **Serb List (SL)**, the **Party of Kosovo Serbs (PKS)** and the **Progressive Democratic Party (PDP)**.

Serb List (SL) is a dominant Serb political party and currently is in power in all 10 Serb-majority municipalities and controls all 10 guaranteed seats in the Kosovo Assembly.

of the respondents consider that democracy is the best form of the rule, and in order for a society to be called democratic, according to the respondents, it is necessary to have: Independence of the judiciary, Free and fair elections, Free and uncensored media, Protection of the rights of minorities, Freedom to be critical of those in power, Shifting political parties that have majority in the parliament.




